A group of Granite State Ambassadors recently ventured out to the New England Tap House in Hooksett for lunch. The restaurant was very gracious leading up to the event as our numbers continued to grow. The rear area of the restaurant can handle 30, but they were willing to let us spill over to an adjacent area in order to accommodate the 40 of us who were able to attend.



We had a delightful experience! They were very welcoming, with the owner Valerie and managers Bill and Stacey coming over to personally greet us. The servers were attentive and the food was delicious. I talked to folks after lunch and it turns out we had a variety of different meals. The nachos with chili and salad that I shared were wonderful, and very filling. A few folks had the hamburger, which visually was very impressive when delivered, and also quite tasty. Some ordered the hamburger sliders, which I understand were also good but a tad less daunting to eat! They had a great number of selections on the menu, and there was



something to appeal to all.

They definitely live up to the "Tap House" in their name. There are 48 beers on tap including local brews, and a few beers that you might not easily find on tap anywhere else. I can personally vouch for the Blueberry Wheat, with real blueberries! Stacey, the Director of Marketing & Event Coordination, came by to tell us a little about the place and answer our questions. She said they would be expanding into the adjacent space next door soon. The New England Tap House is conveniently located off the highway (on Rt 3) and a great spot to send our guests who are either staying in Manchester or heading north. They are open for lunch and dinner Tuesday through Sunday (closed Mondays). Their website states: "Special events throughout the week offer unique entertainment opportunities for everyone.
